Jeff and I had a great time with our team in Egypt. We praise God they are all doing well.

We landed in India and had our time with our first team in the East and were preparing to fly to the North for our teams in K city. We were pulled from the plane 30 minutes before it left. We remain here in Delhi assisting them via skype. Please pray for our teams:

The situation in k is difficult at best, the roads and airport are shut down. They are hunkered down in two locations due to the unrest.

The trouble started when a local news channels had shown this video of a guy in NYC who started burning a few pages of the Qur'an & was escorted out by NYPD guys. Some Mosques got hold of it and within 30 minutes in sighted riots, yet that is not the whole reason they are rioting. There are ongoing protests & revolution for Self-determination rule, as the local people are fed up by the ruling party.

For the first time our teams and other westerns were targeted, and their homes were pelted with rocks. They are now all hunkered down together and keeping a low profile. Pray for peace, stability, Jesus to be their peace and comfort.

One of our teams asked we pray these verses over them.

Psalm 53 10-12 & Ephesians 2:17-18 came to mind. It was timely to remember how our Supreme Victorious Lord was a suffering and servant Lord. Here are some of the verses that stood out for me.

Isaiah 53:10-12

Yet it was the Lord's will to crush Him and cause Him to suffer...
and the will of the Lord will prosper in His hand

By His knowledge the Righteous One, my servant, will justify the many,
as He will bear their iniquities.

Therefore I will give Him a portion among the great,
and He will divide the spoils with the strong
